

Exploring The World of Bokeh

Bokeh is the quality of out of focus points in a photograph. Your objective is to hand in 2 portrait photographs that have an extremely blurry (otherwise known as simplified) background. Remember that the minimum focusing distance of the lens works in conjunction with the aperture setting to produce a nice blurry bokeh. All shots to be done in **Manual Mode**. You are to hand in:

- 1 photograph taken with the 50mm f1.8 lens
- 1 photograph taken with the 70-300mm f4-f32 lens
- Take one with cream cheese Bokeh and one with Hollywood Style Bokeh.
