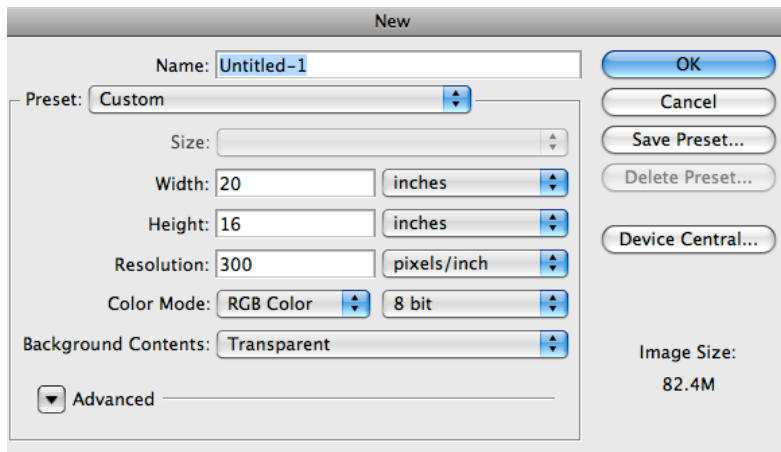


Bromke's Words With Pictures

Your assignment is to hand one finished word created with pictures. By "finished" I mean that they are to have a frame around them and a quotation on them. Similar to this.



1. The word must be at least four letters long. You will also create the background, the frame and the typing that would be an inspirational quote.
2. You must go out and find shapes to photograph that will create your letters. Make sure to get as close as you can so that the letter is a good size in your frame.
3. Once you have your shapes you have to create a 20X16 canvas by going to
File>new



4. Paint bucket your BG layer Black

5. Create a new layer

6. Use the Marquee tool to select an area for your frame. Invert your selection by going to

Select>Inverse Paint it off Black (slightly lighter grey)

7. Redo steps #5&6 but choose white as a colour and create an inner mat. Make sure to drag your mat layer under the frame layer.

8. Crop your first picture/letter- Drag it into your Canvas.

9. If you are not happy with the size-resize the 1st picture. If you are happy with the size move the other picture/letters over -resize as needed. You may need to line them up with the ruler guide line

10. Type in large fancy font the word as in the example. It should not be too bright- subtlety is called for here.

11. Type in the quotation with bright small font. Notice that the person's name is in different plain font.
