2. Find a large, appropriate image on the Internet (historic location, a mountain, a beach, a concert, the forest) and cut and paste this image into your main Photoshop document. Resize and retouch image to fit.
3. Take 2 digital photos of students in the class (or get them to take it of you). Import these images to your computer.
4. Open these digital images in Photoshop and remove the background from the images (for one use the clipping path technique for the other use the lasso tool technique)
5. Cut and paste these photos into your main Photoshop document. Resize and retouch the photos.
6. Add text and a drop shadow. Add any other appropriate layer styles.
7. Save the main Photoshop file as “main_closecrop_yourname.psd”
