

Comic Book Cover

With the success of Marvel movies and DC movies (more or less), I thought it would be fun to create a comic book cover as your large Photoshop project. You will create a new super hero and have YOU —or someone in the class—be that super hero. Think Hero not Zero!!

Requirements:

- 7" x 10"
- 300 DPI
- CMYK
- Must include a photo taken of someone in the class as the new superhero
- Must include the name of the super hero as the title of the comic in comic format
- Must include an issue number (in your case issue #1 because it is the first and only issue of this hero)
- Must include a nemesis on the cover to battle or scheme against your hero
- Must include the price (you decide)
- Must include a barcode
- Must include a star burst image expressing an interesting fact
- Must include a comic book publisher logo
- Look good at 100%

Things to note:

Remember, create your Photoshop document first at the size, resolution and colour space above then copy and paste your images and elements into it. This way, the Photoshop document will always be set up properly.

You must not just take an existing single comic book image and replace the head of the hero, I want you to go in and use many images from many different comics. To create a unique and whacky cover!
