Photoshop is a great program for a number of reasons. One popular use is retouching and enhancing old photos. Meet our happy soldier. After years of neglect, plus going through war, he is looking a little worse for wear.

Your job will be to:

- 1) crop the image to remove the uneven border
- 2) eliminate imperfections in the image, using the clone stamp tool
- 3) remove his cigarette -- he has quit and wants to forget that chapter in his life -- and rebuild his finger
- 4) remove the words from his patch, or the patch entirely
- 5) remove the bandage on his chin --that wound has definitely healed by now!

Open Photoshop and then open the “solider” file on your computer: on the Macs it’s in your document folder, on the PCs it’s found in the S:drive in the “Ms. Forster” file. Tip: Crop photo first, then create a layer copy of the background. Save frequently!

Save the file as “soldier_yourname.psd” in your personal Comm Tech folder .
