

## Grade 12 Foley Project

Add music to an existing Hollywood Classic. First select any appropriate movie you want or use a movie that we have in the class. Using Handbrake Software capture the video clip of your choice using (ipod) quality to the Mac. Crop the clip using Quicktime Pro so it is less than 1.5 minutes in length. Next, in Logic delete all Audio. Compose an interesting song that will enhance your currently silent movie. The music should mimic or foreshadow what is happening in the clip. Recreate all additional sound like dialogue, foot steps and background noise by using or creating Foley sounds. Be creative. Over 1/2 the Foly sounds must be created by you. You do not have to copy the original, but your new audio should work with the video

### Criteria:

- Must be a minute to a minute and half in length
- Must contain logic loops
- Must recreate all dialogue (There must be speaking)
- Must recreate all Foley sounds
- Must have a backing soundtrack
- The song must “fit” together with your movie clip and mimic the action or lack of action on screen
